What is Japanese Knotweed?

Japanese knotweed is an invasive and strong-growing plant, its rapid annual growth and relentless spreading, allows it to easily overwhelm other garden plants.

How fast does it grow?

It can grow at a rate of more than a yard per week!

What damage can it cause?

"It has really a wide-ranging root system, which can extend up to 3m in depth and 7m in all directions. Japanese knotweed can grow through tarmac and cause significant damage to construction works and have devastating consequences to building foundations and drains. The damage caused by its roots and stems costs the economy around £166 million every year in weed control and property devaluation."
